

ADI Installation Checklist – Rev 07/25/06

Please read entire document before beginning installation.

I. Register Software – *ADI Administrator (Only)*

- Make a list of the Autodesk software that will be used at your school this year.
 - Note: Land Desktop is part of the Civil 3D Package and is titled Autodesk Civil 3D-Landesktop Companion
- Register the Autodesk software you plan to distribute or install by contacting Autodesk registration at 1-800-551-1490.

Caution: This step is essential. All software in the ADI must be registered exactly the same.

Note: This is only done one time by the ADI Administrator.

- Obtain product Activation from Autodesk for ALL the products that you have registered by contacting Autodesk at 1-800-551-1490.

II. Pre-Software Installation

If Installing Autodesk **Inventor 11** then the Macromedia/Adobe Flash player needs to be removed from the system. After uninstalling the player the following needs to be run to remove the items from the registry: "C:\windows\system32\macromed\flash\uninstfl.exe". Failure to do this will not resolve the issue with the software deployment. This information is available at the following location:

The installation process will automatically reinstall Flash Player 8a back on to the computer.

- For Serial ATA hard drive computers only: You need to download (but not run) the registry fix below if your computers have Serial ATA hard drives:

Caution: Do not run the registry fix at this point. You will be prompted later in the installation process. Verify that you have Serial ATA hard drives installed since this fix is very specific to these drives.

To determine if you have a Serial ATA HD: Right Click My Computer Icon -> Properties -> Hardware Tab -> Device Manager. Look for Serial ATA device(s)

- Determine what your installation type will be:
 - Deployment Installation** - This supports the following two options:
 1. Network License Manager – Allows installation of software to any number of computers, but only allows the number of computers to run the software that equals the

number of licenses that are owned at one time. For this installation, the computers are connected to the network.

2. **Multi-seat Stand Alone** – Allows installation of the software only to the number of computers you are licensed to run. Computers do not have to be connected to the network.

- Stand Alone Installation** – Normal single computer installation on instructor office or home computer.

III. Deployment Installations

Pre-Deployment Installation- For All Deployment Installations

If you have the Autodesk 2004 or higher deployment wizard installed on your computer, you must **uninstall** the previous version of the Deployment Wizard. To do this: **Control Panel -> Add/Remove Programs**

- Create a shared network folder on the server for each product where installation files will be stored for future use.
- Disable Any Real-Time Antivirus software
- Run the Deployment Wizard for each product to be installed. (See “Installation Tips” Page 3-8)

Note: Multi-Seat Standalone Deployment will run the registration enter the information registered by the Autodesk Administrator.

Network License Manager Installations

- For Network License Manager Installations Only:** Remove the currently installed Autodesk Network License Manager. If you are going to leave installed previous version of Autodesk products, save the current license file to a separate folder on your hard drive labeled ADESK License File 07 for reuse later in the installation process.
- For Network License Manager Installations only:** Install the new Autodesk Network License Manager. Take note of the network MAC address and server network name (This can be obtained by typing “ipconfig /all” at a dos prompt on the computer that will be the License Manager.)

Note: Network License Manager is on the first CD of any of the software products.

- **For Network License Manager Installations only:** Contact Autodesk Authorization at 1-800-551-1491 to obtain a license for the products you are installing as network and how many seats that you want. You will need to have the Serial Number, Product names, MAC Address, and server name.

- **For Network License Manager Installations Only:** Configure the license manager once the license file has been obtained. See p. 37 of the “Installation Guide” for instructions on configuring the Network License Manager. *TIP: You can begin the creation of the deployment files while waiting for the license file.*

Ghosting Software

- For network installations that are using “Ghosting” software Create an image **including the boot sector** before starting the installation.

Caution: Do not start the application at this point. Wait until prompted later in the installation process.

Deploying Software for All Deployment Installations

- Install Autodesk applications you have selected.

- For **Serial ATA hard drive** computers only: Run the registry fix downloaded earlier.

- **For network installations that are using “Ghosting” software only:** Create a separate Image that will be used to distribute. **DO NOT COPY THE ADMINISTRATOR USER PROFILE TO THE DEFAULT USER.** This will not produce the desired results since the application uses fixed application paths per user. There is no need to perform this step to get this software to work correctly.

- **For network installations that are using “Ghosting” software only:** Distribute the software to one test computer.

Now you can run the applications

Run and verify that the applications open without errors. Also login with a student login and verify that there are no issues.

- Distribute software to student stations. **For Software installations via ghosting software only:** Distribute the software as normal.

IV. Stand Alone Installations

- Install the application by selecting the Standalone option when the first CD of the application is inserted. After Installation is complete, the first time that you run the software you will be prompted to register the software. **VERY IMPORTANT! You MUST use the software registration information provided by your administrator when you were given the software media.**
