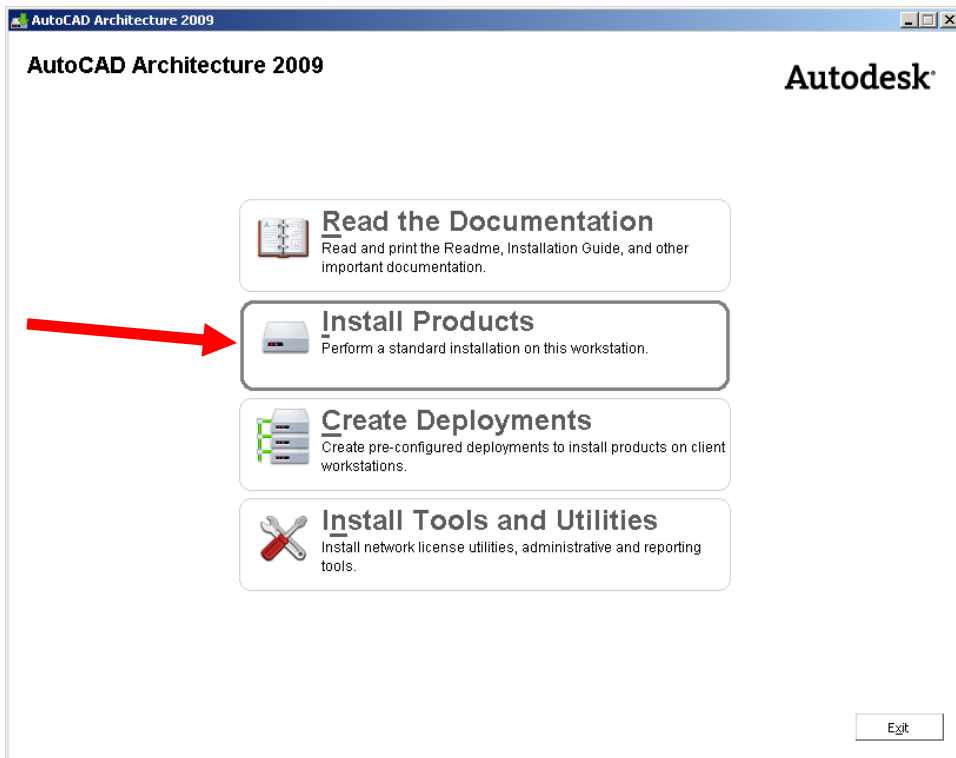
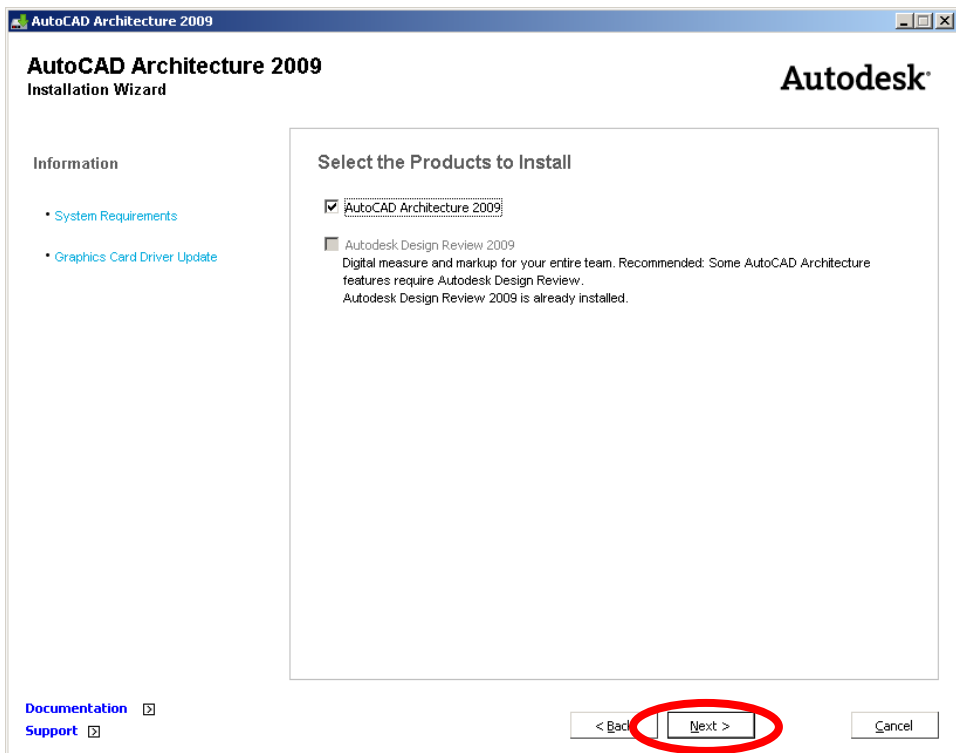


Installation Of AutoCAD Architecture

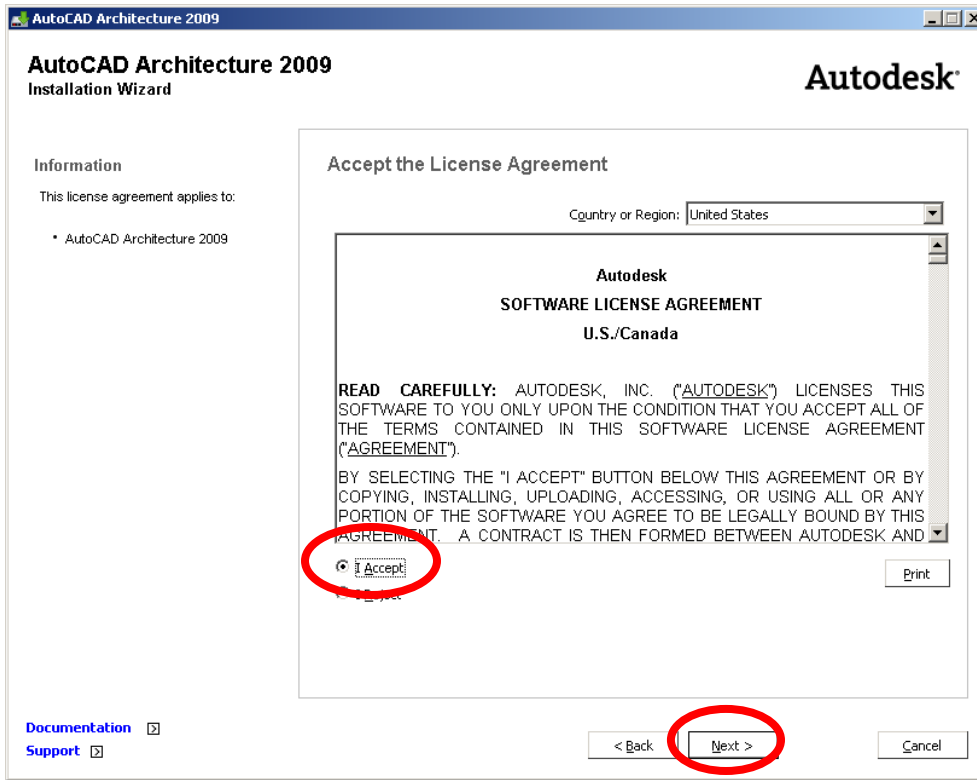
Once the DVD/CD is inserted you will get the following screen. Click the top button “Install Products” to begin the installation.



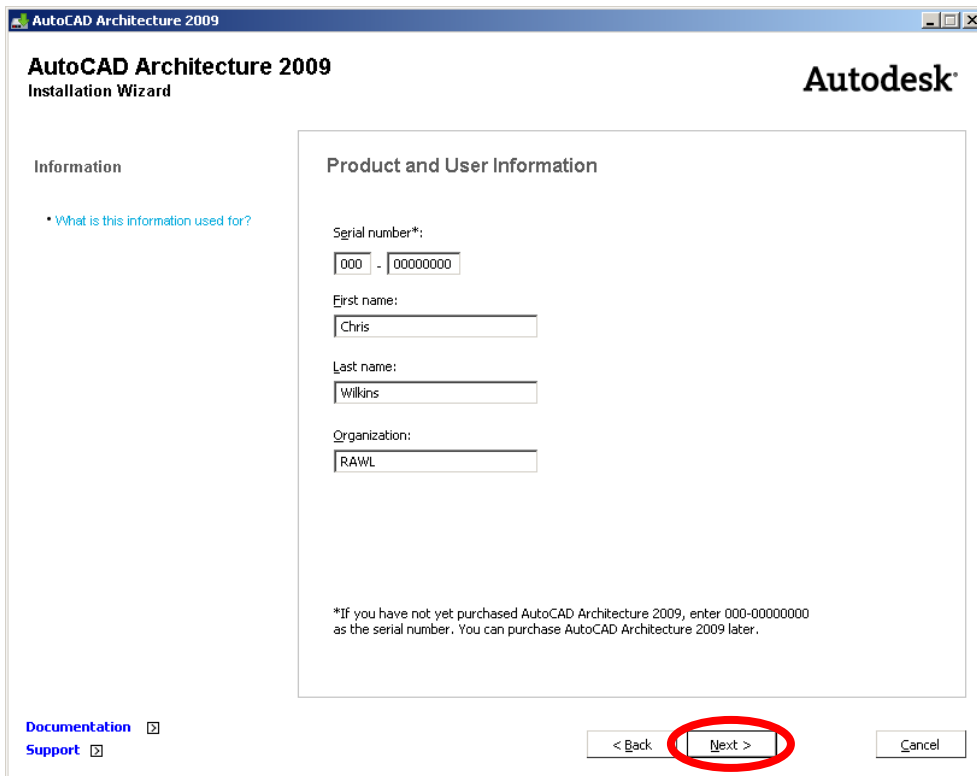
Leave the defaults and choose “Next”



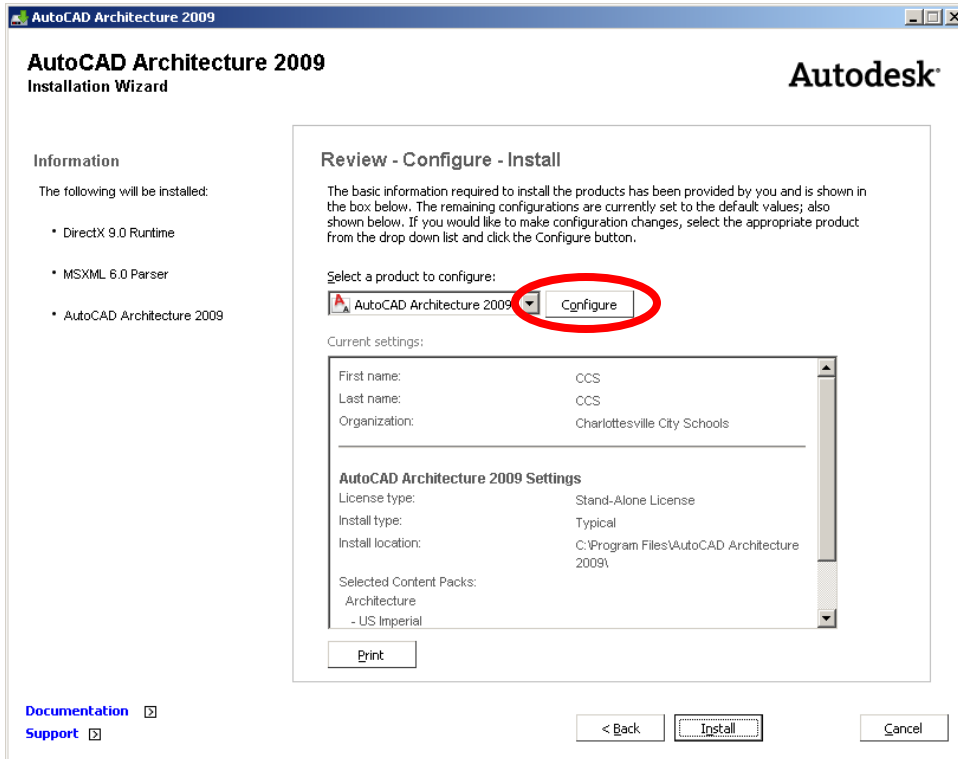
Click “I Accept” to agree with the license agreement after reading it. Then click “Next” to continue.



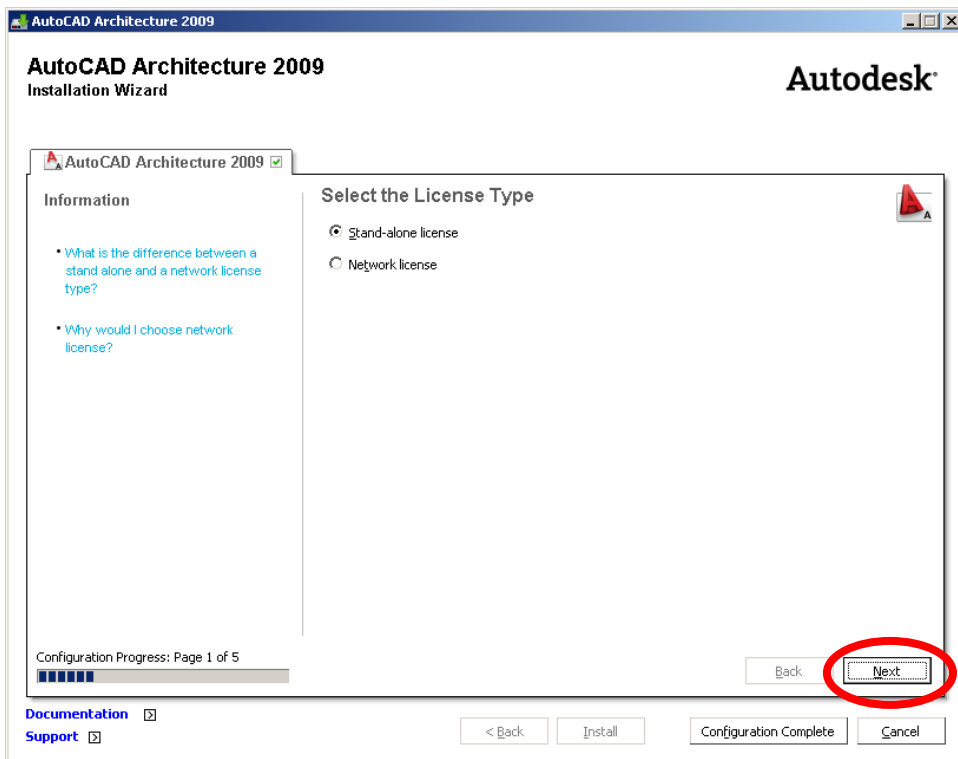
Enter your serial number from the ASDC website then your first name, last name and school. Click “Next” to continue.



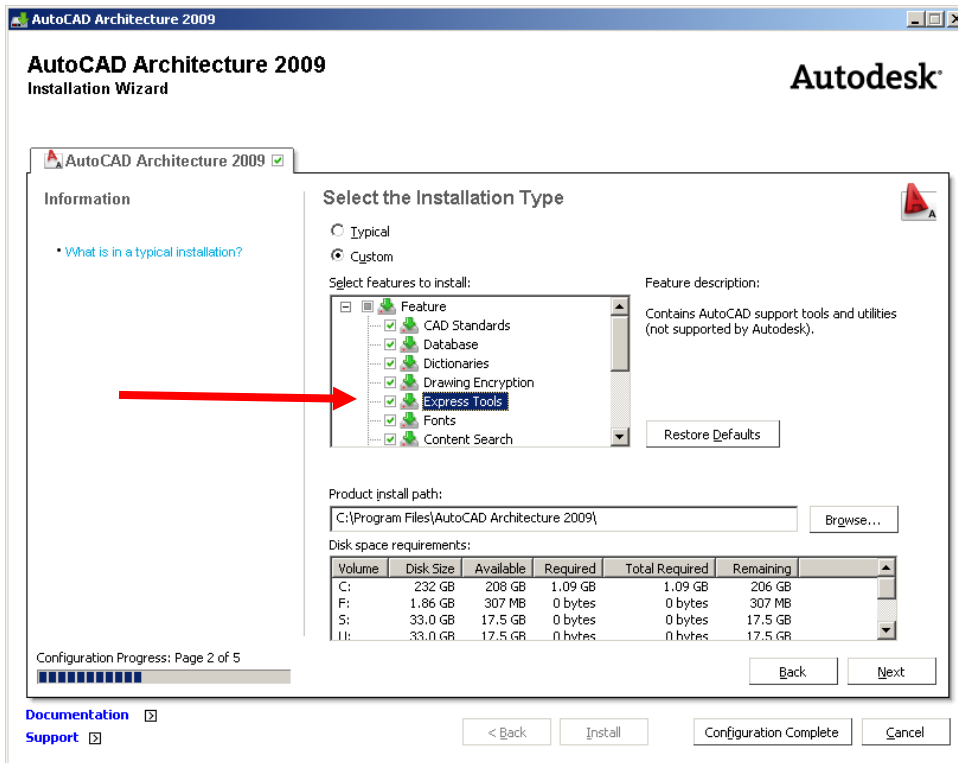
The next screen will appear, choose “Configure” to further configure the installation of the product if you would also like a shortcut for AutoCAD 2008. If not, you would just click “Install” at the bottom.



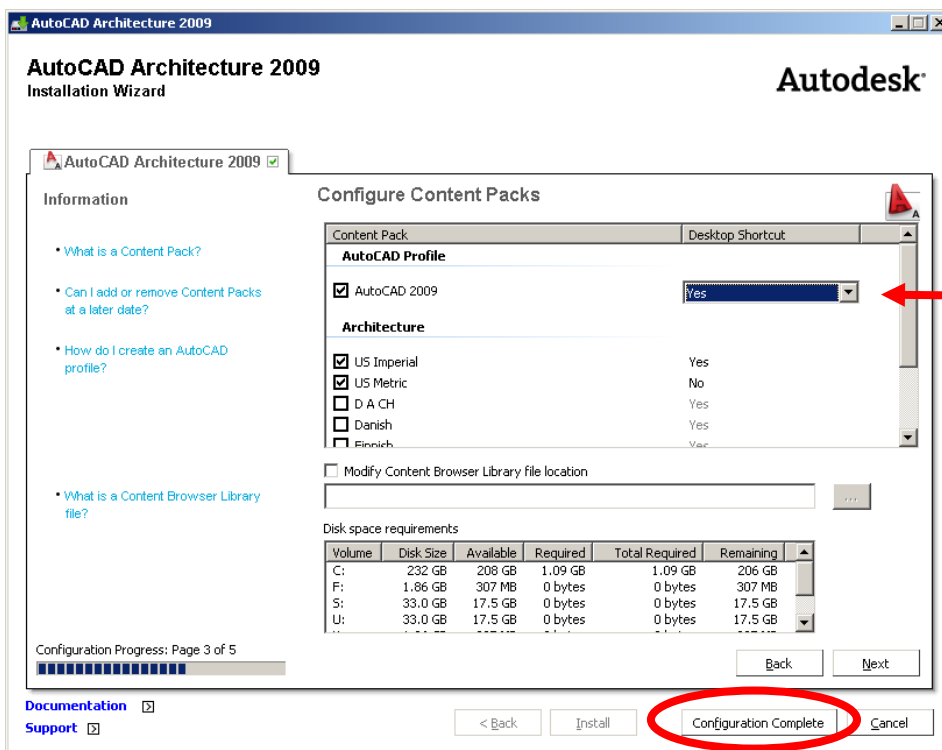
Click “next” to install the software as standalone.



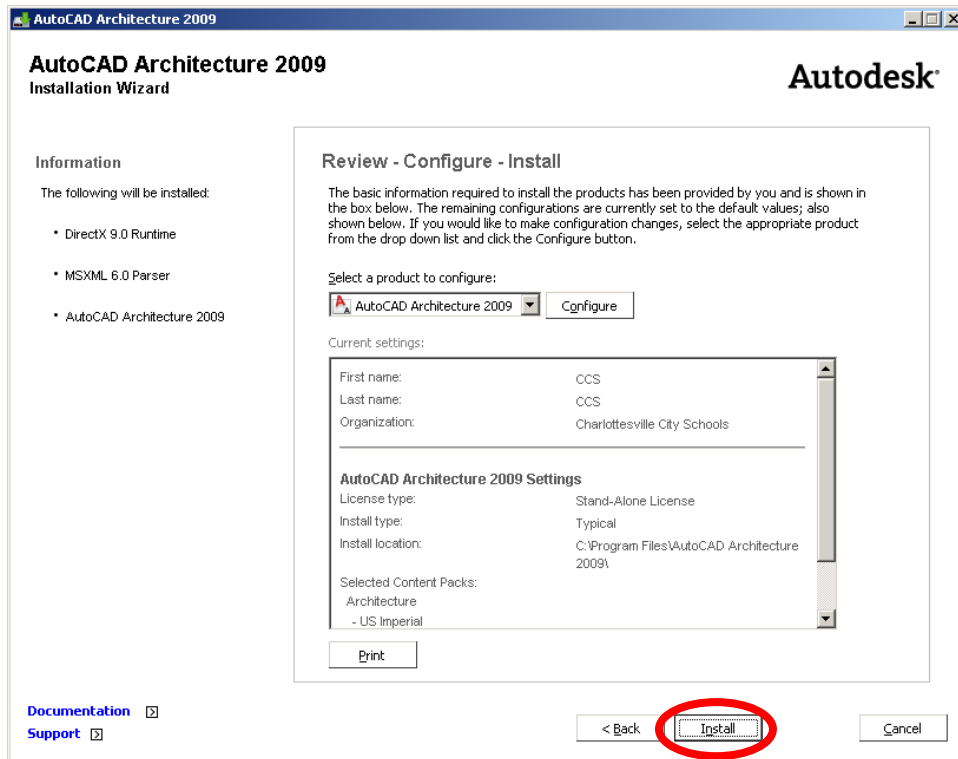
The next screen you need to choose custom and click the box next to “Express Tools” then select “next”.



You should get the screen below; Click the word “No” next to the AutoCAD 2009 profile. This will activate the dropdown you see in the screen shot below, change it to “Yes”. New in this version the default installation creates both a US Imperial and US Metric desktop shortcut. I suggest turning the shortcut off using the same method above to change the “Yes” next to the “US Metric” to “No” Click “Configuration Complete” to continue.



Finally click “Install” to install the product.



After the installation you need to run the application. When the application starts it will ask you to either “Authorize” or “Run”. You can complete the authorize the product by clicking on the “Get Authorization Code” radio button and clicking continue.
